

ORDINANCE 2017-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOLAR, TEXAS RATIFYING THE ADOPTION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 – 2018 MUNICIPAL BUDGET(S) RAISING MORE REVENUE FROM AD VALOREM (PROPERTY) TAXES DUE TO INCREASED PROPERTY VALUATIONS AND THE ADDITION OF REAL PROPERTY TO THE TAX ROLL THAN IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 – 2017 MUNICIPAL BUDGET(S); AUTHORIZING THE CITY SECRETARY TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; INCORPORATING RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ANY OTHER CODE PROVISIONS, ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, AND OTHER PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tolar, Texas has, on the same date and prior to its consideration and adoption of this Ordinance, adopted the Budget(s) of the City of Tolar for fiscal year 2017 – 2018; and

CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOLAR THAT:

SECTION ONE. In accordance with the requirements of Section 102.007(c) of the Texas Local Government Code, the adoption of the FY 2017 – 2018 budget(s), which will require raising more revenue from property taxes due to increased property valuations and the addition of real property to the tax roll than in the FY 2016 – 2017 budget(s), is hereby ratified by the City Council in all things, thereby ratifying the property tax revenues reflected in the FY 2017 – 2018 budget(s).

SECTION TWO. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Secretary to take all necessary steps to implement the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE. The City Council finds all of the above recitals to be true and correct and incorporates the same in this Ordinance as findings of fact.

SECTION FOUR. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared void.

SECTION FIVE. All Code provisions, ordinances, and other provisions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately after passage.
