

**RESOLUTION 2019-02**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOLAR, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE VOTES CAST IN THE CITY'S NOVEMBER 05, 2019 GENERAL ELECTION**

**BE IT REMEMBERED THAT** on this the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2019 at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Tolar, Texas, a quorum being present, the meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted.

Upon motion it was unanimously ordered that the City Council consider the official returns of an election held in the City on the above mentioned date, for the election of, Council Member, Place 1, Council Member, Place 2, and Council Member, Place 3.

**WHEREUPON** said official returns were opened, examined, canvassed and the results declared as follows:

**WHEREAS**, heretofore, the City Council of the City of Tolar, Texas, called an election to be held in the City on November 05, 2019, to elect a Council Member, Place 1, Council Member, Place 2, and Council Member, Place 3 for a two year term; and

**WHEREAS**, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officials holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council as follows, and said returns being made according to law, and duly authenticated, and it being shown that written notice of said election was posted for the time and in the manner provided by law, and all other proceedings pertaining to said election having been shown to have been done and performed at and within the manner provided by law, and all papers pertaining thereto having been returned and filed with the City Council and no protest or objection being made to or regarding any matter pertaining to said election.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Tolar, Texas, after examining said returns and opening and canvassing the votes of said election, which the results of said election are as follows:

That the following numbers of votes were cast for the following named candidates for the office of Council Member Place 1, to-wit:

Matt Hutsell – unopposed	106

It appearing that Matt Hutsell received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Council Member, Place 1 is hereby declared to be elected to the office to serve a two-year term after qualifying.

That the following numbers of votes were cast for the following named candidates for the office of Council Member Place 2, to-wit:

John M. Agee	54
Sally Grimes	62

It appearing that Sally Grimes received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Council Member, Place 2, is hereby declared to be elected to the office to serve a two-year term after qualifying.


That the following numbers of votes were cast for the following named candidates for the office of Councilmember Place 3, to-wit:

Chip Foster - unopposed	105


It appearing that Chip Foster received a majority of all the votes cast for the office of Council Member, Place 3, is hereby declared to be elected to the office to serve a two-year term after qualifying.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this canvass and declaration of results of said election be entered in the Minutes of the City Council and that said officers, after being qualified and having taken the oath, shall serve during the term commencing November 2019 and thereafter until a successor is duly elected and qualified. This Resolution, declaring the results of the election shall become effective immediately after its passage.
